Shortcut	Description
LA	LAYER — Opens the Layer Properties Manager.
LAYERP	LAYER PREVIOUS — Restores previous layer settings.
СН	PROPERTIES — Opens the Properties palette.
MA	MATCHPROP — Matches properties from one object to another.
PR	PROPERTIES — Toggles the Properties panel.

View & Navigation

Shortcut	Description
Z	ZOOM — Zooms in or out.
A / ZA	ZOOM ALL — Zooms to include all objects.
ZE	ZOOM EXTENTS — Zooms to show all visible objects.
Р	PAN — Moves the view without changing zoom.
3F / 3W	3D ORBIT — Rotates view in 3D space.

Block & Object Management

Shortcut	Description
В	BLOCK — Creates a block definition.
I	INSERT — Inserts a block.
X	EXPLODE — Breaks compound objects into components.
REFEDIT	REFERENCE EDIT — Edits a block reference in place.
RENAME	RENAME — Renames blocks, layers, or materials.
WBLOCK	WRITE BLOCK — Saves selected objects to a new drawing file.

File & Printing

Shortcut	Description
CTRL + N	NEW — Creates a new drawing.
CTRL + O	OPEN — Opens an existing drawing.
CTRL + S	SAVE — Saves the current drawing.
CTRL + P	PLOT — Prints the current layout.
CTRL + TAB	NEXT — Switches between open drawings.
QSAVE	QUICK SAVE — Saves without dialog.
EXIT / QUIT	EXIT — Closes AutoCAD.
